PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, federal law designates Monday, June 20, 2022 a federal public holiday observing Juneteenth.

WHEREAS, Illinois law designates Sunday, June 19, 2022 a State public holiday observing Juneteenth.

WHEREAS, the closure of federal government offices and federally-chartered depository institutions on Monday, June 20, 2022 may on that day affect interbank operations in a manner that may physically interfere with the conduct of normal business operations of state chartered banks, savings banks, trust companies and savings associations, and branches thereof, across the State of Illinois.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 2 of the Banking Emergencies Act [205 ILCS 610/2], the Division of Banking hereby authorizes state chartered banks, savings banks, trust companies and savings associations, and branches thereof, to close any and all offices in Illinois for all normal business hours the day of **June 20, 2022**.
